3. It is important you remain well hydrated after the procedure. You should try to drink at least 32 oz of clear liquids within 8 hours after.

RESCHEDULING PROCEDURES:

Please notify our office at least **3 business days prior** to your procedure if you need to cancel or reschedule. A fee of **\$50 may be applied at doctor's discretion**. Please call our office if you have any questions or concerns 575-522-3220 or 575-522-7697.

Colonoscopy and endoscopy are very safe procedures; however, there are minimal risks as with any diagnostic procedure. These risks include perforation, bleeding, infection or side effects from the sedatives.

TWO DAYS BEFORE PROCEDURE: Avoid fruits & vegetables (with seeds), nuts, corn, and beans

IMPORTANT REMINDERS BEFORE THE PROCEDURE:

Preparing for a COLONOSCOPY (DAY BEFORE):

1. On the day before the procedure you may have a regular breakfast (no later than 10 am)
2. After breakfast you will start your clear liquid diet for lunch and dinner. You should drink at least 2 liters of clear liquids the day before your procedure.

1. You must remain on an empty stomach on the day of procedure with the exception of the laxative and clear liquids.
2. You may have clear liquids up to **3 HOURS BEFORE** procedure.
3. You may take the following medications on the day of procedure:
Blood Pressure Medications
Heart Medications
Anti-Seizure Medications

Clear Liquids Include:

Gatorade
7UP/Sprite
Apple Juice or Tea
Kool-Aid
Broth/Bouillon
Popsicles
Coffee (w/o milk/creamer)
Jello

AVOID LIQUIDS THAT ARE:

RED, ORANGE, BLUE & PURPLE

4. If you are insulin-dependant, you take ½ of your evening dose the day before procedure and bring your insulin to your procedure.
5. If you take diabetes pills, you will **NOT** take them the night before or day of procedure until **AFTER** procedure

LAXATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR PM PROCEDURE:

BLOOD THINNING MEDICATIONS

It is important to follow the instructions carefully. Only a well prepared colon will enable us to find all potential abnormalities and will make the procedure safer.

1. If you take aspirin daily, you will **NOT** stop taking it.
2. If you take one of the following medications, you will have specific instructions on when to stop it **OR** if you will continue taking it:
PLAVIX (CLOPIDOGREL) **PRADAXA (DABIGATRAN)**
COUMADIN (WARFARIN) **EFFIENT (PRASUGREL)**
XARELTO (RIVAROXABAN) **AGGRENOX or TICLID**

PREPARATION/LAXATIVE (DAY BEFORE PROCEDURE):

Start drinking the laxative at 2pm and finish ¾ of it by 8pm.

ON THE DAY OF PROCEDURE:

Drink the remaining ¼ of the laxative starting at 4am; You must finish it at least 2 hours before procedure.
